

With reference to your application for the Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship for SC Candidates, I am happy to inform you that based on the recommendations of the Expert Committee; the UGC has selected you for the Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship for SC Candidates, for the year 2014-15.

The tenure of the fellowship is for five years and it commences w.e.f. 1.4. 2014 (or) from the date of Registration under 'hil / Ph.D. (or) from the date of joining in M.Phil / Ph.D. programme, whichever is later. The other requirements and details of the Scheme is enclosed as <u>Annexure-I</u>. The summary of the financial assistance offered under the Scheme are as follows:

The awardee is required to get admission and registration for regular and full time M.Phil / Ph.D. course in a University / Institution recognized by the UGC at the first available opportunity but not later than two years from the date of issue of award letter. Kindly note that this period is not extendable under any circumstances. It may also be noted that the nission to M.Phil / Ph.D. should be taken by fulfilling the conditions of admission of the University / Institution concerned subject to the provision of the scheme as per advertisement of UGC.

It may be noted that the fellowship amount shall be disbursed through Bank to be identified/notified by Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, New Delhi to the bank account of the awardee, (any bank) directly. - 4. The claim towards HRA is subject to the submission of HRA certificate in the prescribed proforma Annexure-VI.
- 5. After the completion of two years of award of fellowship an 'Upgradation Certificate' need to be submitted in the

- prescribed proforma <u>Annexure-VII</u> along with Progress Report and Continuation Certificate.
- It may be noted that UGC has proposed to link "AADHAAR" with student's bank accounts numbers so that there can be direct cash transfer and effective disbursal of fellowship into the bank account of the student. In this regard Secretary, UGC has already requested to universities for helping the students for Aadhaar Enrolment vide his D.O. letter No.F.14-34/2011(CPP-II) dated 11-01-2013.

- 1. The engagement in the scheme/Institute is purely non-regular, time bound and coturminus with the project from 01.05.2017. initially up to 31.03.2018. However may be extended for one year at time up to 31.12.2019 or termination of the project, whichever is earlier, subject to satisfactory performance of the candidate, on the following terms and conditions
- 2. On appointment, he/she will draw a consolidated emoluments Rs.28,000/-+ HRA @ 10% p.m..
- 3. He/she shall have to execute a bond of Rs.100 on appointment.
- 4. A notice of one month will be required to be given by /her/him for termination of engagement. In lieu of notice, a sum equal to one month's total emoluments may be given.
- 5. He/she will be under the administrative control of the concerned PI/Head of Division/Head of Office/Director.
- 6. The engagement will stand terminated on 31.03.2018. However may be extended for one year at time up to 31.12.2019 or termination of the project, whichever is earlier, subject to satisfactory performance of the candidate
- 7. If he/she leaves her/his assignment without permission for one month, the engagement will stand terminated from the date of his absence. In lieu of notice, a sum equal to one month's total emoluments may be given.
- 8. Since she/he has been engaged for the scheme he/she will devote full time for the project work and will not be allowed to do any other work or to accept or hold another appointment with or without remuneration elsewhere.
- 9.. ICAR will have the Intellectual Property / Proprietary right on research outputs of the Project Fellow made during the period of working in the Institute/ICAR as per the provisions of the ICAR guidelines for Intellectual Property Management and Technology Transfer/Commercialization mutatis mutandis. However, in case the Project Fellow has done some research work, her/his name can accordingly be acknowledged/included appropriately in the research paper(s) as solely decided by the concerned In-Charge, NASF Project entitled 'Study the effect of mesenchymal stem cell transplantation on ovarian function and fecundity in goat' and Head of the Institute. No right in this regard can be claimed.

10. He/she shall have no legal right to claim his regularization/appointment by absorption or otherwise against any regular posts or any further contractual engagement on termination of the scheme/project. The engagement in the scheme is purely time — bound, non-regular and coterminus with the scheme/project. The Service of the incumbent shall stand terminated automatically on expiry of the period given here above.

11 She/he is on full time work and is required to adhere to the administrative, financial and disciplinary regulations of the Institute where the incumbent is working. Regular attendance may be ensured by the concerned In-Charge by keeping an attendance register.

12. If any regular academic course by attending regular classes is going on, she/he will have to discontinue the same before joining the above post.

13. He/she will not be entitled to benefits of ICAR Provident Fund, medical reimbursement of an expenditure incurred for medical treatment and any residential accommodation.

14. He/she shall enroll himself/herself to the Aadhar enabled Biometric Attendance System of the Institute at the time of his/her joining and mark his/her attendance regularly.
