Congratulations !! With reference to your application for the **Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship for SC Candidates**, I am happy to inform you that based on the recommendations of the Expert Committee; the UGC has selected you for the **Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship for SC Candidates**, for the year **2014-15**.

The **tenure of the fellowship is for five years** and it commences w.e.f. 1.4. 2014 (or) from the date of Registration under M.Phil / Ph.D. (or) from the date of joining in M.Phil / Ph.D. programme, **whichever is later**. The other requirements and details of the Scheme is enclosed as **Annexure-I**. The summary of the financial assistance offered under the Scheme are as follows:

4.	Escorts / Reader Assistance	@ Rs.2,000/- per month in case of physically and visually challenged candidates.
5.	HRA	As per University / Institution rules.

The awardee is required to get admission and registration for **regular and full time M.Phil / Ph.D.** course in a University / Institution recognized by the UGC at the first available opportunity **but not later than two years** from the date of issue of this award letter. Kindly note that this period is not extendable under any circumstances. It may also be noted that the admission to M.Phil / Ph.D. should be taken by fulfilling the conditions of admission of the University / Institution concerned subject to the provision of the scheme as per advertisement of UGC.

It may be noted that the fellowship amount shall be disbursed through Bank to be identified/notified by Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, New Delhi to the bank account of the awardee, (any bank) directly. The list of designated branches of Bank will be available on the ministry's portal. 2. Half yearly submission of Progress report in the prescribed proforma **Annexure-IV** along with the 'Continuation Certificate'.
3. Details of the expenditure incurred out of the contingency grant to be submitted annually in the prescribed proforma. **Annexure-V**.
4. The claim towards HRA is subject to the submission of HRA certificate in the prescribed proforma **Annexure-VI**.
5. After the completion of two years of award of fellowship an 'Upgradation Certificate' need to be submitted in the

prescribed proforma **Annexure-VII** along with Progress Report and Continuation Certificate.



In suppression of previous guidelines, this new guideline will now be effected from August 2017 for all INSPIRE Fellows

Mode of application: Online

Selection Process:

Two-tier selection process i.e. screening of eligible applications by an Internal Committee, followed by final selection through an Expert Committee shall be used. However, the selection process will be expected to complete within 6 months from the last date of submission of application at the DST and the result of the selection process will be communicated to individual selected candidate through online webportal (www.online-inspire.gov.in) only. No hardcopy of the Offer Letter (Provisional & Final) shall be sent to the candidate by any other modes.

Eligibility:

• **INSPIRE Scholar** having secured minimum 65% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA at MSc or Integrated MS/ MSc course.

• **1st Rank Holders** at University Level Examination (not at Autonomous College Level examination) of overall full time post-graduate program in science, engineering / technology / agriculture / pharmacy / other applied science streams and undergraduate in Medicine i.e. MBBS. However, University shall consider providing 1st Rank to a student having a minimum batch size of 10 students in that University level examination with minimum aggregate of 60% marks of the entire course/ program. Toppers in any subject specialization in post-graduation 2nd year are not eligible. However, shifting/ change of Host Institute or Research Proposal without prior written permission from DST-INSPIRE may be called for termination of the INSPIRE Fellowship. - Positioning under HOPE and Newton Bhabha shall be dealt in separate call. However, in case of availing Newton-Bhabha Internship offered by any other agency other than the DST, the Fellow shall require to obtain written permission from DST-INSPIRE before departure, otherwise it will be treated as absent from the PhD works and fellowship amount shall be stopped during that period.

5. Release of Fellowship amount:

- The fund with respect to INSPIRE Fellow(s) shall be made available with the Host institution by the Department of Science & Technology, New Delhi for payment of the Fellowship along with Contingency Grant to the Fellow(s) following Government of India and Institute / University norms. In such case, Host institute require to register in PFMS (Public Finance Management System: <https://pfms.nic.in>) and needs to provide unique agency code and details of authorized account of head of institute, to DST.
- While to continue release of fellowship in subsequent years, the Host-Institute or the concerned fellow shall submit the financial year-wise Statement of Expenditure & Utilization Certificate (through online portal: www.online-inspire.gov.in) for each INSPIRE Fellow attached to them, the INSPIRE Fellow will be required to submit Progress Report every year duly authenticated by their concerned PhD supervisor.
- To consider of releasing fellowship to an ongoing Fellow, the amount of unspent balance on account of Fellowship including HRA shall be less than Rs 40,000. 6. Up gradation from JRF to SRF:

- The composition of said Committee would be one Member (drawn from the list of Chair-Persons & Expert Members available at the INSPIRE Website: www.inspire-dst.gov.in/List_of_Chairpersons_Members.pdf, depending upon local needs) besides the Research Supervisor of the concerned INSPIRE Fellow and one Internal Faculty as Member of the Committee.
- Choice of external Expert member within the same Host Institute should be totally avoided in this Assessment Committee. The assessment shall be carried out by the Host Institute/ University as per above process and upon assessment, the Fellow shall be required to upload the `Assessment Report` of the Committee in the format of DST of the concerned Fellow, in online portal of DST-INSPIRE for further actions.
- In case performance of any JRF is assessed within one year of the “Effective Date” by virtue 1st Authorship publication, the Fellow must upload the copy of at least one claimed publication along with Assessment Report. Otherwise such assessment shall be treated as invalid.

REPORTS:- The awardees shall submit 1st annual reports for the first 10 months. On the prescribed standard Performa. Ten copies of the first annual report should be submitted after 10 months from the date of commencement of the fellowship giving complete factual details of the research work done through the Guide along with her appraisal. Subsequent annual report should be submitted through the Guide two months before the completion of fellowship tenure. Failure to submit reports in time may lead to termination of the award. Ten copies of the final report in the prescribed form clearly shall be submitted one month before the date of termination of the award. A list of the papers published or presented at Scientific Conferences during the tenure of the fellowship should also be furnished with the annual and final reports.

TA/DA would be admissible as per the rules application to Central Government Officers with basis pay equivalent to the amount of the fellowship stipend.

NOTE:- The expenditure on this account will be met from the contingent grant sanctioned to the fellow.

POST FELLOWSHIP CAREER:-

The Research Fellow can register himself for postgraduate qualification and to utilize in his the work done by him fellowship tenure. - However, shifting/ change of Host Institute or Research Proposal without prior written permission from DST-INSPIRE may be called for termination of the INSPIRE Fellowship. In case a fellow does this on his/ her own without prior permission/ approval, DST-INSPIRE shall not be liable for continuation of his/her INSPIRE Fellowship. Moreover, such shifting/ change of Host Institute may be allowed only one time in 5 years of Fellowship tenure and that too within one year from "Effective Date" of Fellowship at that Host Institute.

4. Short Term Research Internship:

- INSPIRE Fellow shall be allowed for availing short-term Research Internship activities at any national or International Laboratory/ University/ Institute up to a maximum period of 18 months either in one or multiple slots during 5 years of Fellowship tenure. This research internship would either be arranged by DST or by the individual Fellow and, the Fellow shall be required to obtain prior permission from DST-INSPIRE along with recommendation of Ph.D. Research Supervisor as well as confirmation from Research Internship provider for obtaining prior permission. In the event that the Fellow receives full financial support of the overseas institution, the INSPIRE Fellowship for the period of Overseas stay will not be remitted.
- Upon availing the Research Internship the Fellow must submit his/her Internship Report as well as Joining Report to Host Institution, with intimation to DST.
- Positioning under HOPE and Newton Bhabha shall be dealt in separate call. However, In case of availing Newton-Bhabha Internship offered by any other agency other than the DST, the Fellow shall require to obtain written permission from DST-INSPIRE before departure, otherwise it will be treated as absent from the PhD works and fellowship amount shall be stopped during that period.

5. Release of Fellowship amount:

- The fund with respect to INSPIRE Fellow(s) shall be made available with the Host institution by the Department of Science & Technology, New Delhi for payment of the Fellowship along with Contingency Grant to the Fellow(s) following Government of India and Institute / University norms. In such case, Host institute require to register in PFMS (Public Finance Management System: <https://pfms.nic.in>) and needs to provide unique agency code and details of authorized account of head of institute, to DST.
- While to continue release of fellowship in subsequent years, the Host-Institute or the concerned fellow shall submit the financial year-wise Statement of Expenditure & Utilization Certificate (through online portal: www.online-inspire.gov.in) for each INSPIRE Fellow attached to them, the INSPIRE Fellow will be required to submit Progress Report every year duly authenticated by their concerned Ph.D. supervisor.
- To consider of releasing fellowship to an ongoing Fellow, the amount of unspent balance on account of Fellowship including HRA shall be less than Rs. 40,000.

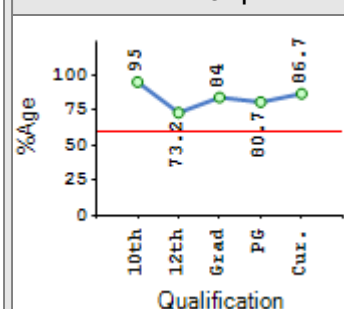

REPORTS:- The awardees shall submit 1st annual reports for the first 10 months. On the prescribed standard Performa. Ten copies of the first annual report should be submitted after 10 months from the date of commencement of the fellowship giving complete factual details of the research work done through the Guide along with her appraisal. Subsequent annual report should be submitted through the Guide two months before the completion of fellowship tenure. Failure to submit reports in time may lead to termination of the award. Ten copies of the final report in the prescribed form clearly shall be submitted one month before the date of termination of the award. A list of the papers published or presented at Scientific Conferences during the tenure of the fellowship should also be furnished with the annual and final reports.

PUBLICATION OF PAPERS:- Prior permission for publication of papers based on the research work done during the tenure of the award should be obtained from the Council. The papers should be sent to the Council through the Guide with his recommendations. Due acknowledgement to the Council should be made in these papers.

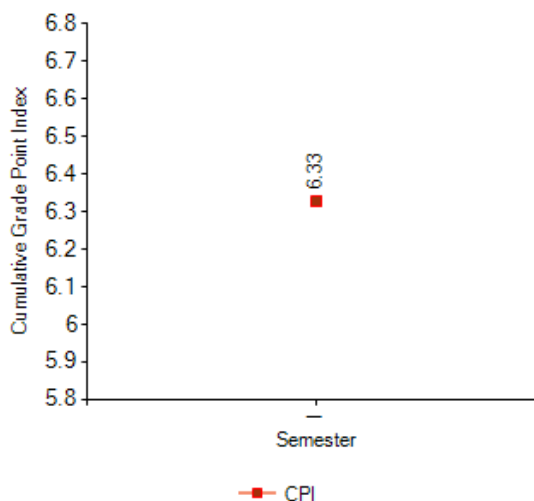
Semester Wise Result





The Director-General of the Indian Council of Medical Research sanctions and allotment for Grand total Rs7,02,200/- (Rupees Seven Lakh two thousand two hundred only) as detailed in the attached budget statement for the above mentioned project for the year 09/02/2020 to 08/02/2021 subject to the following conditions:

1. The grant will be released to the head of the Institution in two installments during the financial year on receipt of the demand in the prescribed form (Appendix-1) as indicated below:-

First and final installment Rs.702200/-

while asking for the release of the installment it may be ensured that the amount for the pay and allowances of the staff who are actually in position is included. The unspent balance available as on 09/02/2020 out of the funds paid during the year 2019-20 should be intimate. This will be adjusted against the current year's grant 2020--2021.

2. A separate account for the grant received and expenditure incurred shall be maintained. The account will be subjected to audited by the authorized auditors of the Institutions. In case, facilities are not available for such auditing, the account will be audited by the Council's own internal auditors. Latest by the end of December, following the financial year for which the grant is paid, and audit certificate from the auditors to the effect that the accounts have been audited and that the money was actually spent on the objects for which it was sanctioned shall be submitted to the Council along with a list of non-expendable articles purchased out of the grant during the year. Any unspent balance would be refunded to the ICMR on termination of the scheme.

Further grants will be stopped unless audited statements of accounts and utilization certificate are received within a period of the year after the end of the financial year for which grant was sanctioned.

3. The last installment of the grant will be paid on receipt of the audited certificate which should included all the liabilities of last year, expenditure incurred before but the defrayed after termination of the scheme. The prior to which the expenditure pertains should be shown clearly.
4. The grant will not be regarded as a subvention, towards the normal work of the Institution but should be exclusively utilized for the Research activity for which it has been sanctioned.

5. Expenditure should on no account exceed the allotment sanctioned for the enquiry. Expenditure incurred over and above the sanctioned amount against one or more subheads of expenditure such as pay allowances, contingencies, etc. shall be met without reference to the ICMR by re-appropriation of savings under remaining sub-heads provided that the total expenditure incurred during the financial year.
No expenditure shall however, be incurred by re-appropriation of savings on items not sanctioned by the Council i.e. non-consumable equipment, stores not sanctioned by the Council Savings shall also not be re-appropriated for meeting on incurring expenditure on staff that has not been sanctioned by the Council.
6. The grant paid by the Council shall be refunded in full by the institution if and when the grantee concerned discontinues a scheme midway or does not follow the detailed technical programme laid down and approved.
7. Receipt, realized by the project officer on behalf of ICMR project, if any, will be remitted to the Council as miscellaneous receipts and not utilized for meeting expenditure of the project.
8. All facilities for conduct of the research scheme basic equipment and ordinary laboratory chemicals, glassware, furniture and other assistance, as may be required, for the smooth working of the research scheme shall be provided by the Institute.
9. The stores purchased out of the grant of the Council shall be entered in the property stock register and presented auditors for check and endorsement. The usual forms used for these registers and all purchases made in accordance with the procedure in vogue in your institution.
10. Only such equipment for which provision has been made in the budget shall be purchased.
11. All the non-expendable articles purchased out of the funds of the Council will be the property of the Council and will not be disposed of without their concurrence.

STAFF

12. The staff employed on the on the research schemes will not be the Council's employee but for all purposes be treated as employees of the Institute and will be subject to the rules and administrative control of the Institute and will be accordance with the normal recruitment's rules and procedures of the Institute.

ICMR scheme shall not apply or obtain patents for any invention/discovery made by them without prior approval of the Council.

18. All the patents will be registered in the name of the Indian Council of Medical Research.

Termination of Research Scheme

19. Prior permission of the Council shall obtained if the investigator desires to discontinue the research scheme. The reasons for discontinuing the scheme should invariably be stated.

20. A final report is required to be submitted within one month from the date of termination of the research scheme.


