xi) GLA University, Mathura will spend grants-in-aid exclusively in pursuance of the objectives envisaged in the Rules/Memorandum of GLA University, Mathura and with the approval of the Competent Authority in each case.

xii) GLA University, Mathura is subject to Economy Instructions issued from time to time

by the Ministry of Finance or by the Competent Authority.

xiii) Grants-in-aid shall be utilized within the stipulated period and unspent balance, if any will be refunded by GLA University, Mathura to the Government of India. All interest or other earnings against GIA should be mandatorily remitted to the Consolidated Fund of India immediately after finalization of accounts. Such advances shall not be allowed to be adjusted against future releases in pursuance of GFR provisions.

xiv) GLA University, Mathura will maintain and present their annual accounts in the standard format as required under Rule 230 (5) of the General Financial Rules,

xv) In case of Non-recurring Grant for specified object:

- a. GLA University, Mathura will have to spend the amount sanctioned to them within the stipulated period.
- b. GLA University, Mathura will have to submit the Utilization Certificate in respect of the grants sanctioned under Rule 238 (1) of the General Financial Rules, 2017 read with Form 12-A, ibid, in respect of the grants-in-aid.
