GLA University has also participated in ARIIA -2021 Ranking (Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements) and secured band-excellent in the category of Private/Self-financed University for the latest ARIIA-2021 ranking announced by Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India. Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) is an initiative of Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India to systematically rank all major higher educational institutions and universities in India on indicators related to "Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development" amongst students and faculties. ARIIA rank band excellent is after the top 10 ranks and only 36 private universities have been given this band. GLA University is amongst the only 5 universities from Uttar Pradesh to feature in top 46 universities across India in the ARIIA-2021 ranking.



Under MoE's Innovation Cell, GLA University has also joined initiative to implement National Innovation & Start-up Policy (NISP). In consonance with NISP 2019 and Uttar Pradesh Start-up and Innovation Policy 2017-2022, the GLA University has formulated its own innovation & start-up policy "GLA University's Innovation & Start-up Policy (GISP)". This policy lay down guidelines for faculty, staff and students to create a robust innovation and Start-up ecosystem in the University. This policy document sets the vision for development and implementation of Innovation and Entrepreneurship activities at GLA University which aims to nurture Innovation and Entrepreneurship culture in the university. It encourages the Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctoral degree candidates and faculties to undertake Entrepreneurship as a career option and set up a successful startup venture. At present, the GISP is awaited to be approved by academic council of GLA University and will be tabled as one of the agenda for next meeting of academic council.
