



**Workshop Details:**

A one-day workshop on “NAAC Accreditation Framework” for Assessment & Accreditation was organized on 30th January, 2021 by the DQAC members, department of CEA, GLA University, Mathura. This workshop was conducted for all the faculty members of the departments of computer engineering & applications. The workshop was inaugurated by Prof. Anand Singh Jalal, Head department of Computer Engineering & Applications.

In view of the need of mandatory accreditation for improving quality of Higher Education Institutions in the country, the main objective of this workshop was to bring together all the faculty members of the department and create awareness among them about the NAAC's Revised Accreditation Framework. In all, 33 participants attended the workshop.

Dr. Pooja Pathak remarks dealt with role of NAAC in assessing and accrediting of higher education institutions (HEIs) along with advising HEIs for quality education. She made a detailed presentation on the Revised Accreditation Framework of NAAC. She explained minute details of the Assessment & Accreditation (A & A) process beginning with the eligibility criteria to online submission of ‘Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA)’. Next, she described as to how the HEI’s applying for A & A process for the first time (Cycle1 Process) has to register and proceed.

Dr. Sandeep Rathor explained all the seven Criteria to serve as basis for assessment of HEIs in detail. The Key Indicators, including the New Introduced ones, were also explained with suitable examples. Dr. Rathor concluded by saying that each and every data should be supported with verifiable document, therefore utmost care should be taken before submitting the SSR.

All the resource persons share their views on different criteria’s of NAAC. The detailed explanation of Criteria-I is given by Dr. Nitin Tyagi. He also discussed key indicators with its metrics. Criteria-II is explained by Mr. Deepak Mangal with key indicators and metrics. The criteria-III that is directly associated with research and consultancy was discussed by Dr. Aditya Saxena in detail. Criteria-IV was discussed by Mr. Gaurav Sharma and Criteria-V was explained by Ms. Gunjan Bhardwaj. Finally, criteria-VI and VII was discussed by Dr. Pooja Pathak.

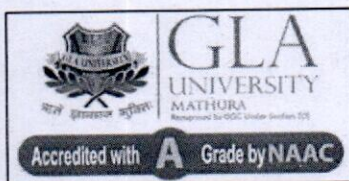

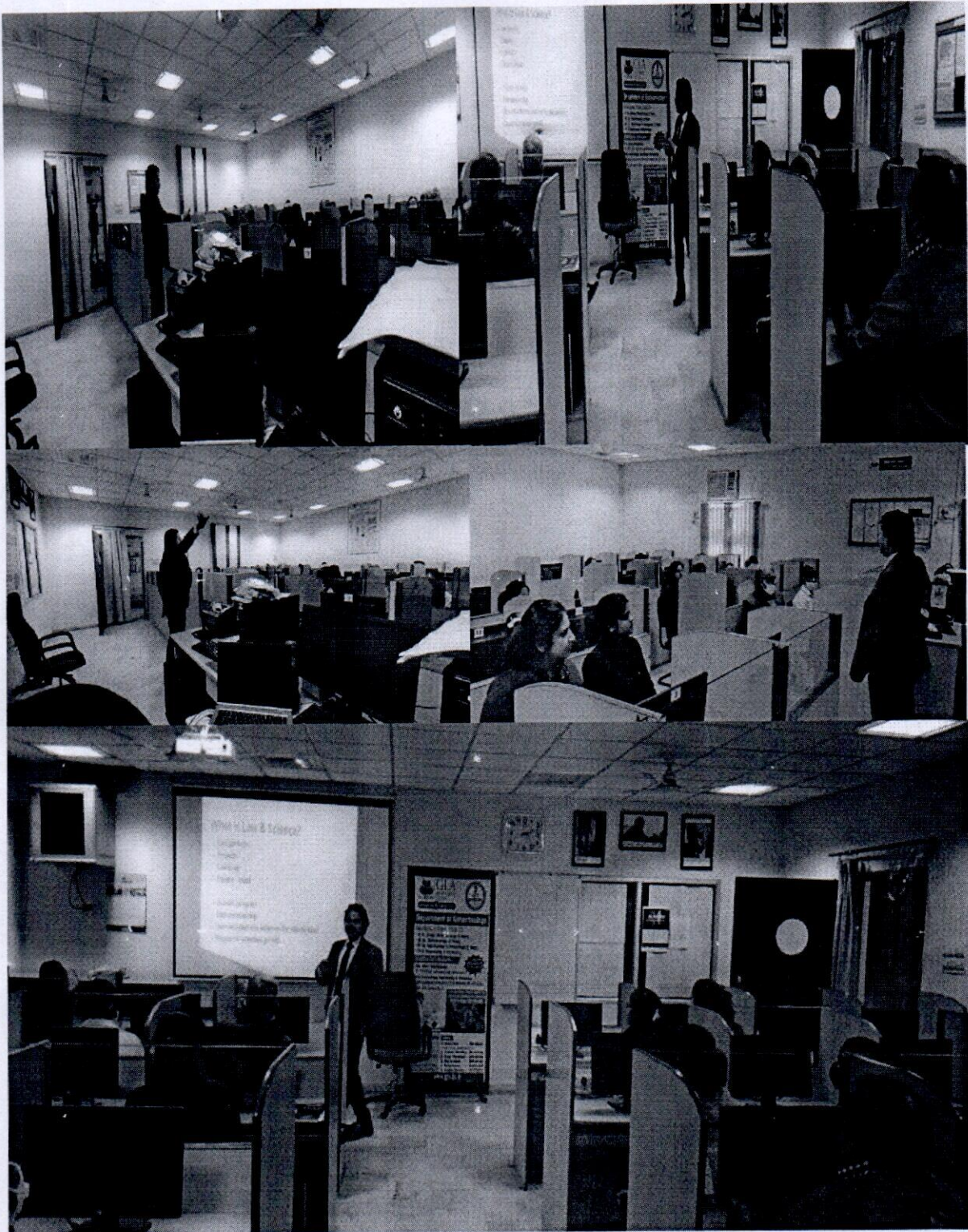

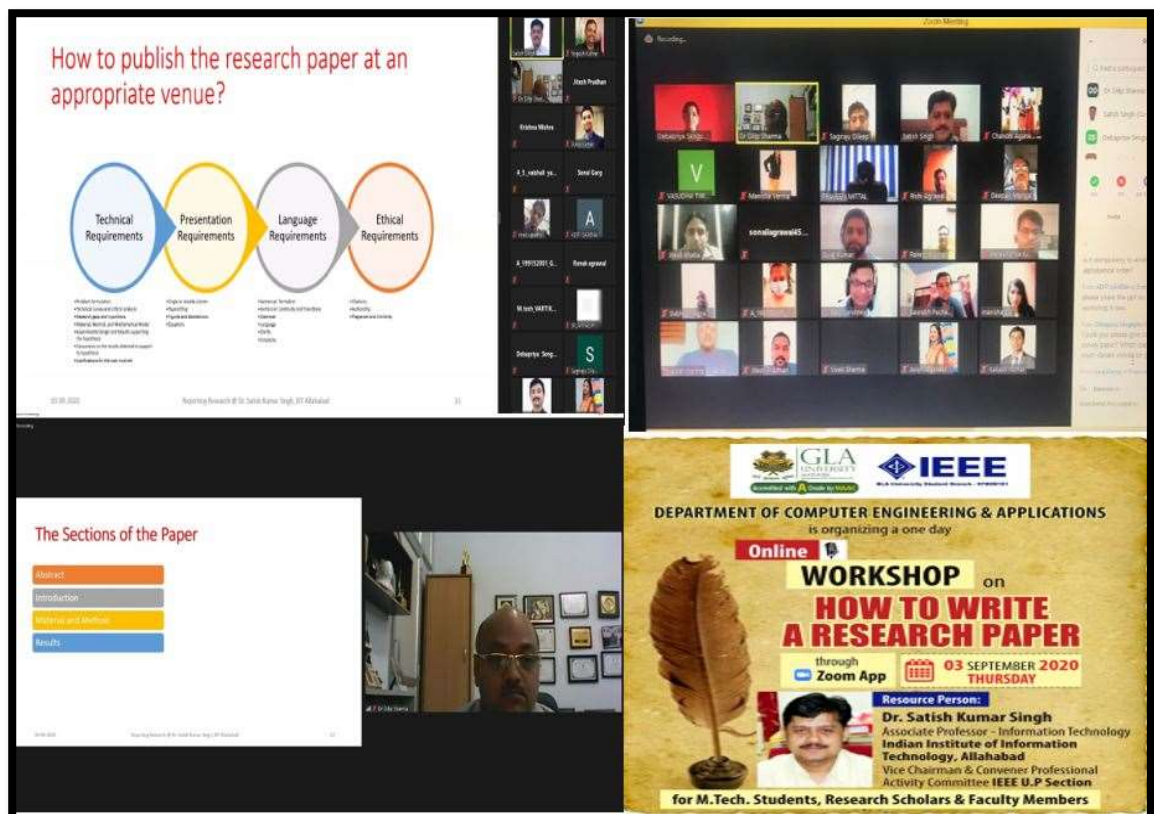

## Tagging COs with Cognitive Levels

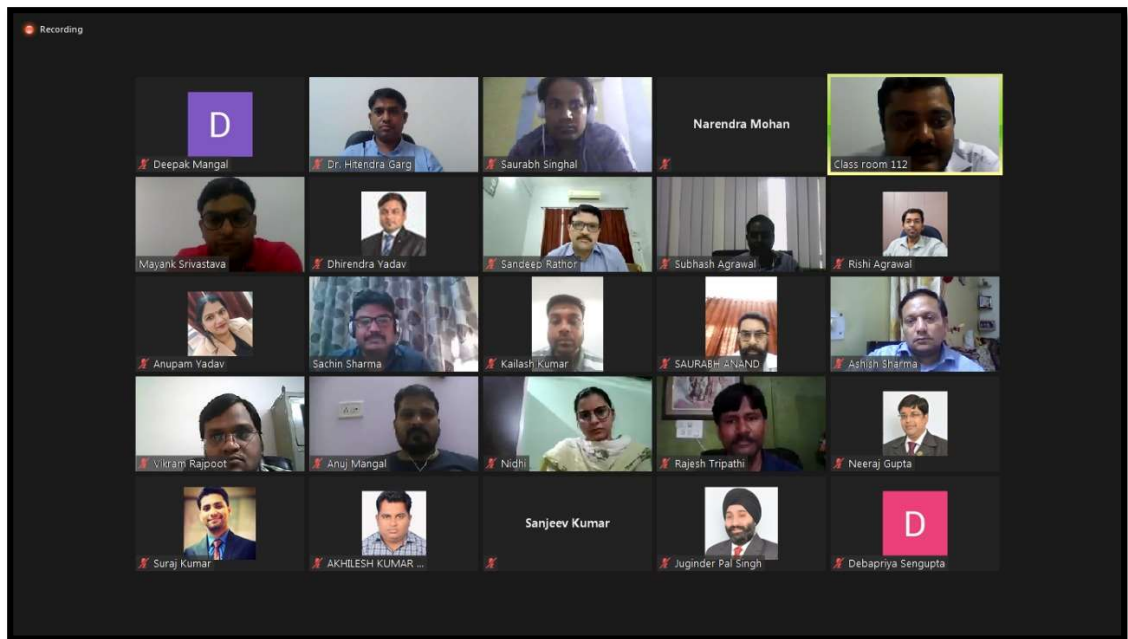
- A **C**ourse **O**utcome statement starts with an **action verb** from cognitive levels.
- The action verb enables you to tag a CO with the **Cognitive Level**. Use the acronyms R-Remember, U-Understand, Ap- Apply, An-Analyse, E-Evaluate and C-Create.
- Occasionally a CO may have two action verbs. Then it is tagged by two cognitive levels.
- As there are no sharp demarcation lines between some cognitive levels, there is a possibility of one Action Verb representing two different cognitive levels. One needs to use judgment in such cases.

Kumar Gupta, Dean of Research and Development, Dr. Anirudh Pradhan, Head of Computer Engineering and Applications Department, Prof. Anand Singh Jalal and Prof. Dilip Kumar Sharma who lighted the lamp to initiate the workshop. The welcome speech was given by Prof. Anand Singh Jalal & the theme was introduced by Prof. Dilip Kumar Sharma. Dr. S.N. Singh during his inaugural address spoke about the five-point spells for good education. He mentioned

that academicians should be expert in TRPIP i.e. the Teaching, Research, Publication, Institutional and Professional activities. Pro-Vice Chancellor, Prof. A.M. Agarwal during his address to YP delegates mentioned that the subject of the workshop is very important a skill development. Because, a better and skilled presentation makes a research to claim national and international recognition.

Dr. Singh also gave a talk on the topic "Effective Writing and Publishing Research Papers", stating that in order to write a research paper the necessary content, language and the image content should be correctly analyzed and placed. Also, the usage of various tables and results for the comparative analysis and study should be used for enhancement of paper. He also added that by using the precise vocabulary one should appropriately define our research. It is equally important to summarize the results and key findings. Referral sources used should be appropriately cited and duly mentioned at the end of the research paper in a chronological order.

Prof. J. Ramkumar, delivered an expert talk on "Effective Patent Filing and Related Issues". He mentioned in his talk that patents in different countries are filed in a number of ways. In India, 20 years of patent term is certain. He stated in his discussions that a research paper can be well used for scientific identification and investigation of technical and social issues. The first writing experience may be scary but if one focuses and organizes his mind then this process can be made easier.

Later, Er. Dhanukumar Pattanashetti, spoke on "IEEE Xplore Digital Library: Delivering Research Better Than Ever" said that the in the age of information, knowledge is expanding rapidly. Today, every organization has a need for the digital library. In this way, students learn about new authors and get various information from these digital libraries, but due its no-availability in some institutions students are being left behind. During the workshop Prof. Sheerish Chowdhury delivered a lecture on "English for

Research Paper Writing". In his lecture, he mentioned that only with correct language, one can express the thoughts and views correctly to communicate a research. He discussed upon the relevance of language usage in research letters, articles, proposals and projects. Prof. Aniruddha Pradhan spoke on "Effective Research Proposal Writing and Related Issues". He emphasized upon need and relevance of a research grant proposal in R & D activity. Prof. Dilip Kumar Sharma delivered a lecture on the "IEEE Plagiarism Guidelines", that

plagiarism is a crime, which puts up questions on the research of academicians. He described it as the act when a research of another person is re-published without making any changes in it, which is an offence.

Lastly, a YP group activity was also conducted: wherein, the participants were divided into small teams of 5-8 each. The team consisted of a mixed group of faculty, scholars and students. A common team activity was assigned to all the groups and was given 10-15 minutes time and asked to pen down the major challenges faced by them in pursuing research or in defining their research problem? Each team was then asked to present the same verbally before host and the host gave them some solutions, guidelines or suggestions. The activity was concluded an open discussion forum for participants. The guests were given mementos by the official of the workshops as a memory of this YP event at GLA University. The Convener of the program was Dr. Dilip Kumar Sharma, co-convener was Mr. Ashish Sharma and YP Convenor, Mr. Vikrant Bhateja (SRMGPC, Lucknow).
