
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A Webinar on "Ethics in Research: Avoiding Plagiarism and other unethical Practices








A session on "Learn the Art of Happiness: The Bhagavad Gita way"

He spoke about the long-term anger management which requires a comprehensive routine of self-care. According to him, self-care is a series of activities which a teacher can do to take care of themselves. He emphasized to incorporate a self-care strategy for teachers given the stress level of the job. He gave some examples of self-care activities including meditation, prayer, or other spiritual activities; good eating and sleeping habits; personal hygiene; getting enough exercise; maintaining relationships with family and friends; and even talking to a professional or therapist.


