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

## Initiatives taken for Eco-friendly Campus

Department of English, GLA University, Mathura.

- Our department has devised a variety of activities to promote carbon reduction. To reduce air pollution and to promote global ecological development, we have come forward to increase attention in the whole GLA University by taking the right decision. We have taken a Departmental pledge that no personal vehicle would be used on Saturdays by our staff members. The residents in our GLA premises come by walk on that day and those who come from other places use GLA Bus on Saturdays. This is the first step to raise the awareness of the public that when individuals change their habits, this can bring forth the real change in society.
- To inspire in our GLA students an understanding and appreciation of the natural world and help them to make responsible decision about the environment our Department runs 'a nature club' to stop the degradation of the planet's Natural environment and to build a future in which human beings live in harmony with nature by:
  - conserving the world's biological diversity
  - ensuring the greenery of the university campus
  - reducing pollution and regulate waste management.

We arrange a lot of Adventurous trips to our students to botanical Gardens, Naturopathy Centres, Nature study trips etc. To our credit, we have planted 8875 trees in Mathura alone within 5 years. We organize community programmes. we involve the school children of Mathura City to participate in competitions in Art like: on the spot drawing and painting and slogan writing.

• To bring out the inherent talents of our students we encourage the young minds to participate in Group Discussion, Debate, Declamation, Publication on topics of eco-friendliness like: Local Eco-friendly Development, Public Value in Eco-
