



Radhakrishnan was the first vice-president of India and succeeded RajendraPrashad to become the second President of the country. On September 5th of 1882, Radhakrishnan was born into a Telegu Brahmin family in Tirutani in Andhra Pradesh. He did his Masters in Philosophy from the University of Madras And later, went on to teach in University of Mysore and University of Calcutta, where he was also popular among the students. The first Teachers Day was celebrated in 1962, the year when President Radhakrishnan assumed his office.
